She has taught at colleges, conferences and classrooms and curated fellowships for emerging leaders. Dasha has served as Poet Laureate for the City of Milwaukee and the State of Wisconsin.

Her first major work, *The Haunted Carousel*, won the 2014 NBA Young Band Composition Contest. As a conductor, Dr. Svanoë has held residencies with the USAF Heritage of America Band, the Atlanta Freedom Bands, and numerous universities. She has held collegiate appointments at Augsburg University, Bemidji State University, and the University of New Hampshire and remains active as a guest conductor and clinician, appearing with high school, university, and festival ensembles across the United States.
